FEDERAL BUDGET



- Current Federal fiscal year (FY 17) and Current funding expire September 30, 2017
- Administration released its proposed FY 18 budget earlier this year:
 - *Generally D.O.A. but does outline priorities*
 - *Proposed spending in total (approximately \$4 Trillion) on par with prior year, however....*
 - *Significant changes to proposed funding levels for many programs and offices including energy related*

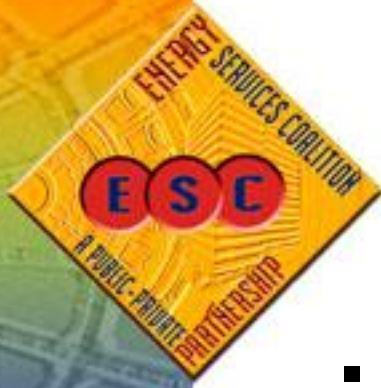
FEDERAL BUDGET



Current status:

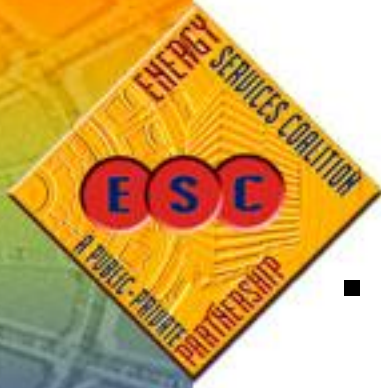
- House passed appropriations bill prior to August recess
- Includes significant cuts to DoE, including FEMP
- SEP and WAP remain flat
- Unlikely to pass in current version in the Senate
 - Senate working on appropriations bills also- includes cuts to EERE
- Some disconnect between Congress and administration
- Likelihood of a CR (Continuing Resolution) to fund the government past September 30, 2017
- Also likely need to address the federal debt ceiling around this same time

GESPC/ESPC – TRUMP ADMINISTRATION



- History of administration support going back to Clinton administration
- Obama administration supportive of performance contracting:
 - Included Presidential directives, E.O's, goals and challenges
- Alignment between ESPC and focus on environmental stewardship, emissions reductions, sustainability and federal leadership in these areas

GESPC/ESPC – TRUMP ADMINISTRATION



- Also supported by sound business case

- Solid Congressional support
 - Bi-partisan
 - Bi- cameral
 - E.S.P. Caucus

- Federal agency support and utilization including significantly DoD
